1000 m W of Bimini USGulf near New Orleans, fought off U-106 Rasch at 04:00 on 27 May 42, 4,639 US flag used guns (US victory? Sande?)

1500+ nm NE of Great Abaco, in North Atlantic, c.460 miles south of Cape Race, Nova Scotia, enroute Barbados to Canada
